Any reference to the 'Club' includes officers, committee members, trustees and servants of Swanage Sailing Club.

1. - I confirm that all craft I berth or use at the Club are fully INSURED including THIRD PARTY insurance liability cover for not less than £2,000,000.
2. - I understand that members of the Club, their guests and visitors, may use the Club premises and facilities entirely at their own risk and explicitly accept that:
 - The Club will not accept any liability for any damage to or loss of property belonging to members, their guests or visitors to the Club.
 - The Club will not accept any liability for personal injury arising out of the use of the Club premises, and any other facilities of the Club, or out of participation in any race organised by the Club, whether sustained by members, their guests or visitors or caused by the said members, guest or visitors, whether or not such damage or injury could have been attributed to or was occasioned by the neglect, defaults or negligence of any of the officers, committee or servants of the Club.
 - Before inviting any guest or visitors onto the premises or to participate in events organised by the Club, members will draw their attention to this rule.
3. - Racing: The Club shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner / competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in races. Moreover every owner / competitor warrants the suitability of his yacht for the race or races and undertakes to provide third party liability insurance as detailed above.
4. - **Junior Members.** Parents & Guardians are warned that the Club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of Club racing, or during other organised activities. Parents and guardians have full responsibility for their children, and must appreciate that the Club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control. Even during Club racing the Club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other persons, whether engaged in racing or general sailing.
